Background

PhD, University of California Davis Research Emphasis:

- Understand factors that promote adolescent health and reduce risk taking behaviors
- Translate research and theory into the development of interventions targeting multiple levels of influence including the individual, parents/caregivers, health care providers, schools, health systems and public policy
- Build the evidence-base for effective interventions





Primary Projects

Preventing Unintended Pregnancy:

- PCORI: Developed an app to support adolescents decision making around use of contraception.
- OAH TPP Social Network Intervention: Facilitate peer communication about highly effective contraceptive methods to improve uptake of LARC

Improving Outcomes for Adolescent Parents & their Children

 Advise and evaluate MCAH's strengths-based case management program to promote resilience among expectant and parenting youth





Future Directions

- Expand mobile health application to promote sexual health of all adolescents: males, LGBTQ, non-sexually active youth through user-driven, individually tailored content
- Improve partnerships between parents, providers and youth to promote adolescent health
- Disseminate and facilitate adoption of evidencebased intervention into practice
